Studying for Review Unit Exam

1. Review all vocabulary on the learning target sheet—there are 10 matching vocabulary questions. You'll also need these terms for multiple choice and essays as well.
2. There are 5 multiple choice questions. Review all note sheets, use bullets on the learning target sheets, and listen to class reviews this week for ideas of how questioning. Plus 1 Listing Question.
3. There are ~~10~~⁵ short answer questions—2-3 sentences. They are given in a true/false method (we'll review in class) and then you have to **confirm their truth** with 2 support details or **prove their falsehood** with 2 support details.
4. There are ~~2~~³ long essays—these have been reviewed with your short quizzes and essay. IF YOU DID POORLY on these, you need to go through your notes/textbook and add to your answers. We also reviewed the correct answers in class—hopefully you added to your notes then. Additionally, one of the long essays is taken from your colonial essay so review your essay. Again, if you did poorly on essay, you may need to add more detail to it.

To Be Considered for Retest, you must have done 1 of the following pre-test strategies prior to test day.

- ① Come to review session and actively participate.
- ② Answer the learning targets thoroughly on lined paper and turn in prior to test.
- ③ Sent practice long and short essays by e-mail to Mrs. Sharkey by Tues. 4 PM.
